

RTAC is strongly opposed to any and all plans or proposals which in any way reduces or reschedules the amount which CPS is required to contribute to CTPF. The most recent proposal made by CPS to CTPF would hurt CTPF's funding ratio and our financial security. The proposal defers \$505 million of the 2016 \$704 million due on June 30, 2016. You are urged to express your opinion on this matter to the CTPF Board of Trustees and the CTPF Executive Director on or before Wednesday, July 15, 2015.
